First and second on the Cincinnati speedway was the best win they put over last season, however, as the two Frenchmen had trouble making the light speedy mounts stand up for the distance. At Uniontown both turned "turtle" whil running one, two, and the latest dope on the Frontenacs is to the effect that they will be kept in the stable this season.

Gaston signed up to drive a Deusenberg, and the Atlanta races will be his

first appearance this season.
